24. INFORMATION SECURITY

Data Centres:

Patronus Safeguarding is hosted on third party servers situated in London UK.

The data centres are operated by our subcontracted hosting services provider and maintained to both ISO 9001 (Quality) and ISO 27001 (Information Security) standards. They are manned 24/7/365 by dedicated security personnel and benefit from secure physical access controls and CCTV monitoring.

Data encryption

All data entered and held in Patronus Safeguarding is encrypted in transit and at rest.

SSL encryption takes place between the Authorised User's computer and the Patronus server when Patronus is accessed and between the clients' MIS and the Patronus server when data is being transmitted through the automatic extract.

The SSL certificate enables the Authorised User's computer to verify that the site into which they are entering data is, in fact, the Patronus server. Connections are encrypted with 256-bit AES Encryption. 256-bit AES encryption is applied to all data stored in the Patronus database.

Data resilience:

Data resilience using Heroku and AWS is achieved through a combination of robust infrastructure and reliable backup strategies. Heroku, built on AWS, leverages the cloud provider's high-availability zones to ensure data is always accessible, even in case of localised failures. Heroku Postgres, for example, includes automated backups, point-in-time recovery, and failover capabilities to protect your data from unexpected incidents. Additionally, AWS services like S3 provide durable, geographically distributed storage for long-term data retention, ensuring redundancy and minimising data loss risks. Together, Heroku and AWS create a resilient environment for safeguarding critical application data.

Access control

Patronus uses multi-factor authentication to ensure that only Authorised Users can access The platform.

Access requires the Authorised User to enter:

- a. Their unique user identifier
- b. A strong password, and or
- c. A unique passcode generated by an authenticator app
- d. Single Sign on via an authorised IDP

Audit controls

All access to Patronus and key actions performed within Patronus, e.g. creation, modification and deletion of Content, are time, date and user stamped. Consequently, an audit trail is maintained that accurately records all key activities undertaken using Patronus. This provides additional security by providing the ability to investigate and analyse what has been done, by whom and when.
